## NOTICE

The National Fisheries Authority wishes to inform all mud crab fishery licensed companies and the public that the two-month further extension for the mud crab fishery buying, storage, and export licenses will end on Monday, 21st October 2024. That means, the buying, selling, storing and inter-port transfer of mud crabs purposely for export will cease effectively on Monday, 21st October 2024.

All licensed companies are hereby advised to submit ALL necessary data and reports to the National Fisheries Authority by Close of Business (COB) on Monday, 21st October 2024.

As per the Fisheries Management Act 1998 and the Fisheries Regulation 2020, penalties will apply to any person/s or companies that continue to buy, sell, store and export mud crabs after the said closure date.

Please note that this notice does NOT affect the harvesting, buying, and selling for local consumption or to local markets, restaurants, and hotels.
