PUBLIC NOTICE

EXTENSION OF THE MUD CRAB FISHING SEASON

The National Fisheries Authority (NFA) wishes to inform all Mud Crab Harvesters, Licensed Buyers, Exporters, and the General Public that the Mud Crab Fishing Season is extended for another two (2) months period for the 2023-2024 season.

The reasons for the extension are premised on the following.

- 1. The TAC for each province is set at 50% of the standing stock biomass of each province.
- 2. The sporadic spawning behavior of mud crabs allow for natural replenishment of their population
- 3. The utilization of the resource to its full potential will provide continued social and economic benefits to coastal communities; and
- 4. Encouraging continuity in business investments and commitments to end markets to be fully utilized.
- 5. Encouraging and exploring potential farming opportunities for commercialization.

The extended fishing period will be from 21st August to 21st October 2024.

During this extension period, only existing licensed companies will be allowed to continue with the Buying, Selling, Storing and Exporting of live Mud Crabs and no new licenses will be considered.

Further, in this extension period, Gulf and Central Province fishing grounds are Prohibited from harvesting, and trading of Mud Crabs within the provincial jurisdiction for commercial or export purposes, as they have already reached their Total Allowable Catch (TAC) for the 2023-2024 open season.

However, Gulf and Central Province-based companies are allowed to purchase mud crabs from other provinces through facilitation by their Provincial Fisheries Office, for the purpose of storage and export only. Utilization of their facilities in Gulf is consistent with the provisions of the mud crab management plan, particularly Schedule 2 (Inter-provincial Transfer Form).

The Mud Crab Management Plan-2022 [G619] encourages the Buying, Selling, Storing and Exporting of Mud Crabs from respective maritime provinces who have yet to reach their TAC allocation during this extended fishing period.

All the licensed companies, including those based in Central and NCD are advised to submit all daily purchase record data, which should include purchases made in other maritime provinces to the National Fisheries Authority during this extension period.

Please note that penalties are applicable per the Fisheries Management Act 1998 as amended and the Fisheries Regulation 2000 as amended, to companies and individuals who breach the conditions of this extension period.

This notice does **NOT** affect the harvesting, selling, and buying for local or domestic consumption or sale to local markets, restaurants, and hotels.
